- School begins at 9:00 AM. Drop off begins at 8:45. Anyone who arrives after 9:00 AM please ring the bell as all outside doors are locked to ensure the safety of our students. If you walk your child into the building or walk to pick them up, please park on the right side of the drive or in one of the lots off of Edgewood Avenue. The left lane is the drop-off lane and pickup lane. Please hold your carpool number up at pickup. Pickup begins at 11:45. If your child will be riding home with someone not listed on your pick up list, you will need to send in a signed and dated note.
- *IMPORTANT* during pickup children must be holding hands with an adult at all times. Teachers will walk children to you and hand them off. Please remind your children of this.
- Birthday celebrations are very important to us! If you would like to send in a special snack, please check with your teacher about allergies that may be in your child's class.
- Please do not send drinks to school with your child. We have filtered water to go with our snacks. Sippy cups and juice boxes are not necessary and cause confusion when some children have them and some do not.
- Please do not send your child to preschool if they have a fever (must be fever free for 24 hours), a persistent cough, a thick runny nose, vomiting, or diarrhea. Germs are something we encourage not to share. Immunization records or exemptions are due by the end of the month!
