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Capital Campaign & Renovation Update

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Greetings from the Planning/Building & Capital Campaign Team:

We want to give you an update on the completion of the Building renovation project and also an update on the results of the Capital Campaign and the results to-date.

Building Renovation:

With the re-hanging of the Tartans in Tartan Hall, our renovation is all but complete. We are still monitoring one issue with our concrete (some minor "spider" cracks have developed) and hope to have that resolved over the summer. In addition, the Building & Grounds Ministry is working on the completion of the landscaping and we look forward to the final results.



As we walk through the various sections of the building and Sanctuary, we still marvel at the wonderful work that was done and how we are able to honor God with our space. Many of the items completed look as if they have always been in place: the Sanctuary floor, the front chancel, the bright finishes of the Narthex and Arcade. Looking at the bright and welcoming space of our Education building and the ability of our youth and adults to learn and enjoy fellowship has made the long project all worthwhile. We are especially pleased with the accessibility that was created: seating in the Sanctuary for the physically challenged, the elevator and the bridge that is now a focal point of our wonderful facility. Thanks to everyone for the support and patience with the wonderful work that was done by Trehel Construction.



Capital Campaign:

We are past the halfway point of the Capital Campaign commitment period and want to update you on the status of the campaign. The original building project came in on budget at \$2,883,925. We received pledged commitments totaling \$1,945,409 and have collected approximately \$1,355,870 of that total. In addition, we have received \$668,380 in several unpledged gifts, from families in the congregation, giving us a total of \$2,024,250 to date. This leaves \$1,148,265 to be paid, plus any additional interest payments on our outstanding construction loan.

As we have moved past the midpoint of the pledge period (1/2 way point for some who pledged over a longer period), we want to encourage everyone to consider completing their pledge as soon as they are able. This will ensure that we keep the campaign on track, as we continue our efforts to faithfully Glorify God, Grow Disciples, and Meet Human Needs.

Again, many thanks to all who have contributed towards this project and we look forward to your continued support of the ministry at Fort Hill.

If you are new to Fort Hill, it is never too late to make a pledge and help us reduce the amount of the loan we will take in order to meet the project cost.
