- There will be no school this Friday, March 30th thru April 6th. School will resume April 9th.
- Priority registration is now closed. Most of our classes are full with waiting lists. If your plans have changed please let me know as soon as possible.
- Now is a good time to revisit our policies and procedures. They are posted on the preschool website as well as in our handbook that was sent home the beginning of the year. Reminder please no sippy cups, rolling backpacks, or umbrellas.
- We will have school April 30th. This is a snow makeup day for Pickens County Schools. Our policy states we do not have to make this up but our teachers have worked it out and we will have school this day! Make this change to your calendar!
- Pick-up starts at 11:45 and concludes by 11:55 most days. Due to an increased number of children being picked up late repeatedly, we are instituting a policy of charging \$1/minute for getting here after 12 noon. Picking your child up late is disruptive to not only your child, but to the teachers and their schedules. Time after the children are gone is used for meetings, classroom clean-up and set up for the following day. We understand this happening from time to time but please be prepared to pay this penalty for repeated occurrences.
