A Year in Review

From where I sit, this last year has been full and wonderful. As pastors, we have the privilege of walking with folks on a faith journey. And one of the joys of ministry is working with families preparing for their own or their child's baptism (6 baptisms), couples preparing for marriage (5 couples), youth in confirmation (1 confirmand), saints who have died and their families (15 families). That does not include all the faith conversations over coffee, email, in the car, in a group, and on the way. God has given us so many opportunities to care for each other, to speak grace and kindness to one another, to learn and grow together.

Additionally, God through the work of our Officer Nominating Committee, thoughtfully brought a slate of deacons and elders, and nine servant leaders are preparing to serve Christ and his Church.

We have welcomed two new staff members, Kelly McCord, Faith Formation Coordinator, Pat Rabun, Congregational Care Associate, and several interim music staff whose help is a gift: Scott Dillon, Kaleigh Stagich, and Porter Stokes. Also, we prayed for God's blessing on the new calls of Margaret MacKay to the joy of retirement and of Mary Morrison, Chaplain of our Foothills Presbyterian Community in Easley.

Other wonderful accomplishments we have made with God's help:

- Over \$130,000 in General Budget for outreach ministry to mission partners near and far, not to mention all the special offerings and giving beyond our budget.
- A new playground for our Preschool and young disciples.
- Retirement of the Mortgage on the 2016 Renovation of the entire building which
 made our meeting house accessible with the Stair Tower/Elevator, upgraded
 spaces for youth, music, and children, and connected our buildings with the
 Bridge which faces College Ave.
- Growing youth, college, and family ministries along with new adult Bible Studies.
- Upgrades to our Sanctuary and backyard in the works to improve our ministry.
- The formation of the Healing Bridges Counseling Center for our community.

That list does not include all the steady, ongoing, faithful service our usual ministries provide. Fort Hill has a cooperative, team-based, shared ministry and mission model. The skills and talents God has given each of us are to be used for the Glory of God. And thanks be to God, for the riches of God's grace shown in you, Fort Hill. It is an honor to serve as your Pastor and to seek God's will together for our church, community, and this world.



Finance Ministry Update

Through November, pledge and offering income was \$1,029,185 while expenses were \$1,003,492 for a surplus of \$25,693. Overall, expenses are 7% below budget, while income is 3% under. Thank you for your continuing financial support to Fort Hill! If you have not returned your 2025 pledge, please prayerfully consider your pledge for the coming year, so Fort Hill can continue its ministries to members, community, and around the world.

Bridging Generations Update:

Through the end of December, total income was \$244,402.62 out of \$409,994 in total pledges. We spent \$180,000 of those funds to pay off the Building Fund loan with the final payment made in June. The balance and additional money received will be used for projects which include replacing the sanctuary 33-year-old lighting system and updating the sound technology for in-person and online worship. Another project is the development of the outdoor space in the "backyard" that all ministries of the church can use to support their specific activities.
